By developing and manufacturing innovative technologies, DCL International Inc. is advancing efficient de-carbonization and supporting clean energy initiatives, demonstrating its unwavering commitment to environmental improvement and innovation. DCL International Inc. produces goods in Canada and sells and distributes manufactured goods within Canada and internationally. DCL International Inc. imports goods into Canada that are produced outside of Canada.

DCL International Inc. acknowledges that modern slavery (which denotes serious forms of exploitation such as human trafficking, forced labour, child labour, and other slavery-like practices including debt-bondage) is a risk globally, including in developed and emerging markets. Like all companies and consumers, DCL International Inc. possibly faces a risk of involvement in modern slavery in our supply chains, particularly because some of our suppliers could possibly be in countries reported to have modern slavery.

As part of our wider commitment to promoting ethical business and employee welfare, as well as our ongoing obligations to comply with all applicable laws relating to modern slavery in all jurisdictions, DCL International Inc. strives to ensure that modern slavery is not taking place in our supply chains and business operations. Respect for human rights is consistent with our values and drives the way we work. DCL International Inc. will not knowingly engage in modern slavery or partner with any supplier who engages in these practices. DCL International Inc. will be assessing our supplier's policies and practices to identify, assess and mitigate modern slavery risks in our supply chains and operation. For this first initial reporting period, DCL International Inc. does not have information available and are currently in the developing stage. DCL International Inc. has submitted its report and questionnaire.
